Focus Text: Isaiah 61: 1-4, 8-11	Intersectionality is the interconnected nature of race, class, gender, etc. To understand taking action it is vital to understand the critical nature of intersectionality. Watch Kimberle' Crenshaw's Ted Talk on "The Urgency of Intersectionality". God understands the full impact of intersectionality and brings good news of deliverance to all.  What are your own identities, privileges, groups, and positions that intersect or overlap? Who are the people/groups with power and privilege? Have the groups changed over time? How do you contribute to the marginalization of a group? How can you take different action? Is bias involved? If so, how?	One of the most common action items with racial bias is to talk about it especially with children. PBS kids has a video with all of their favorite characters having open and honest conversations about bias and race. Check out the link below.
